





Grande Oaks is one of the few centers in Ohio that provides ventilator services and respiratory therapy. Our ventilator unit provides patients with BiPAP and CPAP monitoring and breathing treatments. Our in-house physician and respiratory therapists are on-site 24/7 to regularly monitor respiratory needs. All of our respiratory therapists are certified or registered, and our nursing staff consists of RNs, LPNs, and STNAs.

We have a proven track record of weaning patients from ventilator support, oxygen therapy and trach decannulation.

Our comprehensive pulmonary program offers a variety of services including but not limited to:

- 24/7 respiratory therapists
- Ventilator care
- Trach care
- Pulmonary hygiene
- Aerosol treatments
- CPAP/BiPAP care



Our Pulmonary and Respiratory Care Program is available to both short-term and long-term residents. Our program supports those with the following conditions:

- Mechanical ventilator dependence
- COPD
- Acute respiratory distress and ailments
- Emphysema
- Neuromuscular disorders
- Post-surgical complications
- Spinal cord injuries
- Stroke and brain injuries
- Metabolic encephalopathy
- Tracheostomy
- Gastroparesis

When short-term residents are ready to return home, our care team will train the patient and their family/caregivers to correctly perform proper care routines like trach suctioning. They'll also be provided with guidelines and warning signs that indicate a problem or infection that requires medical attention.
